LOCATION

- ABSOLUTE LOCATION
 - □ 32.8000° N, 35.6000° E
- RELATIVE LOCATION
 - Southeast of Europe
 - Southwest of Asia
 - North & northeast of Africa
 - Borders 3 continents: Europe/Africa/Asia
 - Northwest of India Ocean

Crossroads between Asia, Europe and Africa

MOVEMENT

□ Goods – oil, foods, salt, major trade crossroads

□ People - Refugees, empires have conquered area

Ideas – Iron-making, canals, first alphabet,
 Christianity, Judaism, Islam

REGION

- Northern Tier stretches across Turkey and Iran, dry, mountainous land
- Arabian Peninsula Land is flat, elevated plateau, desert
- Fertile Crescent stretches between Tigris and Euphrates rivers, crops grow well here
- Nile Valley part of Cradle of Civilization, in Egypt, crops grow well here

PHYSICAL FEATURES

- Climate hot and dry, desert climate
- Major bodies of water Red Sea, Mediterranean, Indian
 Ocean, Nile River, Tigris River, Euphrates River, Persian Gulf
- Major Deserts Sahara, Rub al-khali, Syrain
- Mountain Ranges Atlas, Zargos
- Major Peninsulas Arabian, Sinai
- Major Natural Resources Water (very scarce), oil, copper, salt,

- Political Divisions (countries)
- Peoples Arabs, Jews, Turks, Iranians/Persians, Greeks, Kurds, Palestinians
- Languages Arabic, Kurdish, Hebrew, Turkish,
 Persian/Farsi, Greek, Armenian
- Major Religions-Islam, Judaism, Christianity
