# Instructions for completing the $8^{\text {th }}$ Grade Registration Card 2014-15 

ACADEMIC CLASSES: Every student will be assigned four academic classes. The classes are Language Arts 8, Science 8, Social Studies and Math.

Accelerated Math and Advanced Language Arts: If you are currently in an advanced/accelerated class, you will move to the next class in your sequence. If you are planning to move to an advanced/accelerated class, you must take a test and meet the district criteria.

ADVANCED LANGUAGE ARTS: Students wanting Advanced English placement must complete a written application, an examination and a writing sample. The testing date will be announced. There is a summer reading requirement. This class requires more difficult reading, writing, and includes a greater volume of work.

ACCELERATED MATH: Most students will move to the next math class in the sequence. Parents will be notified by the current math teacher by the end of May if this is not the case for their child. District criteria must be met in order to place in a math class not in sequence. Students enrolled in Algebra 1 or Geometry will receive high school credit. The credit earned will not affect the student's GPA in high school, but will be counted toward the 22 credits needed for graduation. (1-2 credits) This course is for high school credit. (1 credit)

WORLD LANGUAGE: Students have the opportunity to take a World Language. They should indicate their $1^{\text {st }}$ and $2^{\text {nd }}$ choices. Students successfully completing the Level 1 Language course in $8^{\text {th }}$ grade can then take Level 2 of that Language in $9^{\text {th }}$ grade. As in math, they may receive high school credit toward the 22 credits needed for graduation. Please be aware that once enrolled in $8^{\text {th }}$ grade Language, it is usually not an option to drop the language class during that school year. This course is for serious and organized students. (1 credit)

ELECTIVE CLASSES: The Elective classes will complete a student's schedule. Please rank ALL of the Elective classes in order of preference. Availability of elective classes is determined by staffing and student requests, therefore student preference is not guaranteed.

Instrumental Music should only be ranked if it was taken in $7^{\text {th }}$ grade or special arrangements have been made through the counselor; otherwise, leave it blank.

All other classes should be ranked with "1" as the top choice, " 2 " as the second choice and so on. Rank classes from 1-6.
Personal Fitness: Sports - Students passing the Personal Fitness curriculum will receive $1 / 2$ of a High School credit.
