<p>EFFECT: Sent the message to ordinary people that religions & all classes of people were <u>equal</u></p>	<p>EFFECT: Built <u>new churches</u> & hired ministers to help in their new Christian life</p>
<p>EFFECT: People became <u>passionately and emotionally involved</u> in their <u>religion</u> (not just passive listeners)</p>	<p>EFFECT: <u>Universities</u> were established - Kings College (now Columbia University) & Princeton University</p>
<p>EFFECT: First "American" event which <u>unified</u> the colonies</p>	<p>EFFECT: Spirit of independence spread, which inspired colonists to write <u>Declaration of Independence</u> separating them from Britain (American Revolution)</p>
<p>EFFECT: People began to <u>study the Bible</u> at home</p>	<p>EFFECT: Gave people <u>hope for salvation</u> (possibility of death in colonial times was everywhere - severity of climate, disease by insects, animal attacks, high fevers, floods, malnutrition, complicated childbirth)</p>
