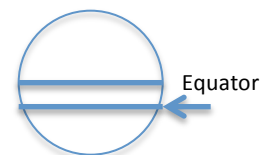
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What kind of map identifies the country borders, capitals, and major cities?

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This latitude line is $23\frac{1}{2}$ degrees NORTH of the equator.

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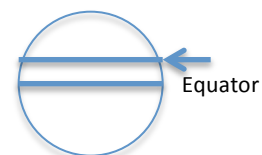


This latitude line is $23\frac{1}{2}$ degrees SOUTH of the equator.
