


Henry Clay - Creates a compromise


Missouri - Slave state

Congressman David Wilmot first introduced the proviso in the United States House of Representatives

Goal was to make the issue of slavery a topic in national politics. To this point it was avoided or dodged.


Sectionalism

Henry Clay creates another compromise:

- 1. California is a FREE state
- 2. Utah & New Mexico Territory to be decided by popular sovereignty (people there vote)
- Texas dropped its claim to land north of the
 32nd parallel north
- 4. Slave <u>trade</u> was abolished in Washington, **D.C.** (but not slavery itself)

Illegal to assist or hide runaway slaves


You must return to owner


Nicknamed the Bloodhound Law
