<ul> <li>an individual enters into society with certain basic rights and that no government can deny these rights (Life, liberty, property)</li> <li>individuals willingly surrender some of their natural or inalienable rights in exchange for protection by the society in the form of laws and rules</li> </ul>		all people and institutions must follow the laws, which are fairly applied to everyone	governmental power is restricted by law, usually in a written constitution	the condition of being equal, or the same in quality, measure, esteem or value especially before the law
