

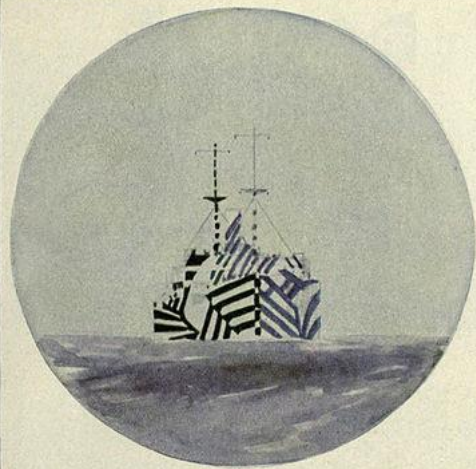

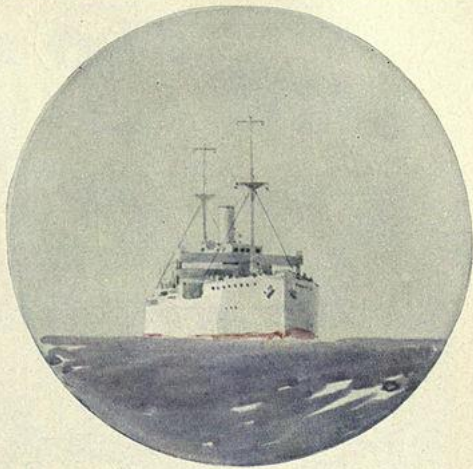

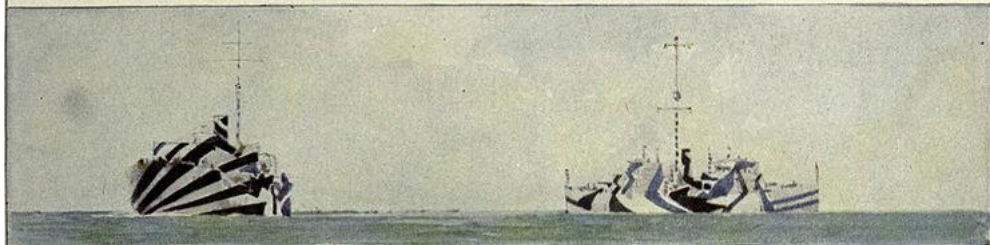




Merchant vessel dazzle-painted as seen through a submarine periscope.



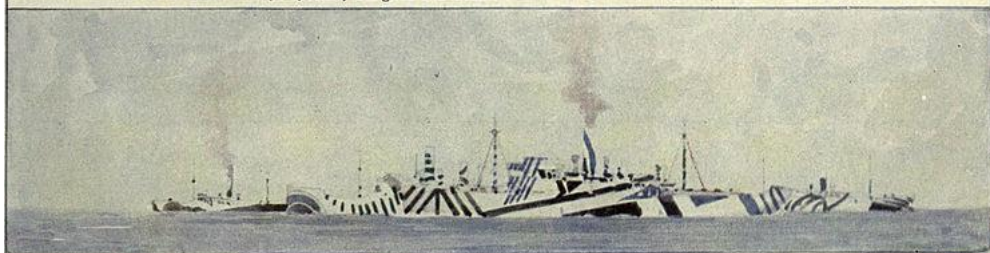
The same vessel on identical course painted grey.

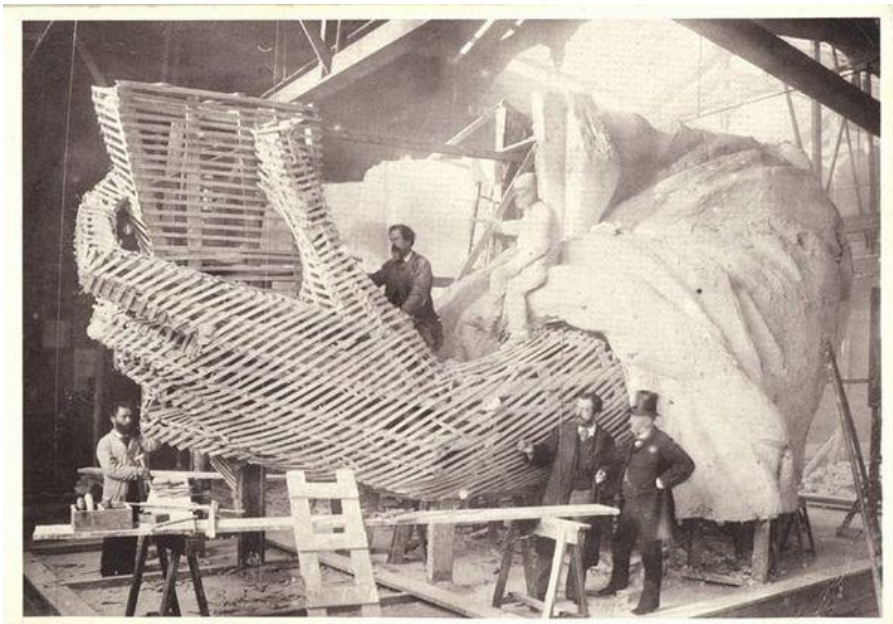
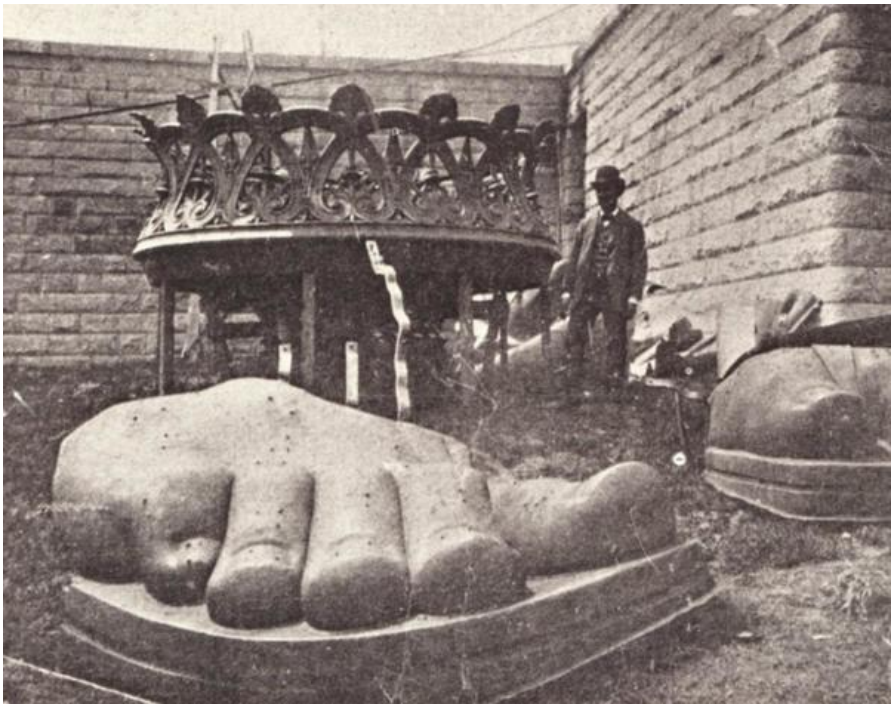
Two ideal types of ships specially designed and dazzle-painted for protection against submarine attack.

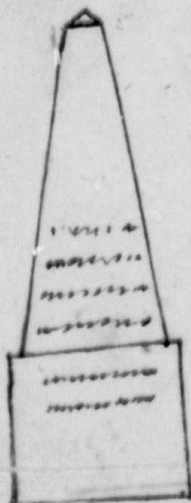
