

Washington Steps Down

- Farewell Address - a letter published in 1796
- Two major points
 - Warns against political divisions at home - no political parties
 - Warns against becoming “entangled” in European disputes and wars
“Steer clear of permanent alliances”
- Washington stepping down is significant
 - Establishes 2 terms / 8 years
 - Stepping down allowing someone else to become president
 - No uprising, rebellion, death, etc.
